Some of his involvement included President of the Western Canadian Wheat Growers, founding member and Vice President of Grain Growers of Canada, President of the Canadian Agri-Food Trade Alliance and director on many other boards and committees.

Mr. Menzies was first elected in 2004, as the Member of Parliament for the Southern Alberta federal riding of Macleod. In 2006 he was appointed Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of International Trade as well as to the Minister for the Canadian International Development Agency and later Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Finance in 2007.

In January 2011 he was sworn into the Queen's Privy Council of Canada as Minister of State for Finance. Mr. Menzies retired from federal politics at the end of 2013, becoming President and CEO of

CropLife Canada representing Canada's plant science and biotech industry as well as a member of Crop Protection Strategy Council of CropLife International, until retiring in 2017.
