Ag for Life Delivers Agriculture Safety Education on Wheels

Putting a Spin on Rural and Farm Safety

(Calgary, Alta) – Agriculture for Life (Ag for Life)'s Rural Safety Unit is on the road traveling to communities, schools, fairs, festivals and other events to educate, encourage and promote rural and farm safety.

With a long-term goal of reducing the number of agriculture-related injuries and fatalities, the mobile unit focuses on visiting Alberta's rural communities. This includes attending the highlyanticipated Whoop-Up Days taking place in Lethbridge. For the first time since 2019, a full slate of programming and events is set to take place from Aug. 23 to Aug. 27 and the Rural Safety Unit will be one of the many attractions!

The mobile unit offers users the opportunity to learn while engaging with digital, tactile and mechanical interactive displays. Safety topics include: Hazard Identification, Large Animals, Large Equipment, Utilities, Risk Assessment, Chemicals and Protective Equipment.

"Agriculture is reported to be one of the most hazardous industries in Canada, with many agriculture workers and their families suffering serious incidents and fatalities each year," said Luree Williamson, CEO of Ag for Life. "With an estimated reach of over 30,000 children, youth and adults per year, the mobile unit is the perfect vehicle for delivering rural and farm safety education and helping to build stronger, safer rural communities."

The Rural Safety Unit operates between April and October each year. School programs are geared towards grades 6–12 and community event programming can be tailored towards families attending.
