

BEE Egg Painting Activity

MATERIALS

- Egg (can be raw or hardboiled)
- Yellow and black paint
- White construction paper
- Black marker
- Glue
- Scissors
- Paint brushes

Please note: Hardboiled may be easier to handle for young children but keep in mind painted eggs are not safe to eat. If you want an alternative to a real egg to display, try using a plastic Easter egg.)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Paint the egg yellow and let it dry for a few minutes.



Paint black stripes onto the egg. If this is too difficult for younger children, black stripes can also be drawn on with markers. Let dry.



Draw wings onto construction paper. Cut them out and glue them onto the bee. Let glue dry.



Using a black marker, draw a face on the bee.



*Enjoy your bee friend.
Remember, painted eggs are not safe to eat!*
