Your Life, Your Agriculture

Suggested Grade Level: 10-12

<u>Description</u>: Many lucrative and exciting careers exist in agriculture, and a large number will remain unfilled in the upcoming decades. Introduce students to agriculture career opportunities that align with their passions, strengths and interests.

Time Required: 45 minutes

Resources Required: Internet Access

'What's Your Something' Document

Timeline	Activity	Purpose
5 min	Introduce the topic of Careers in Agriculture by "Your Life, Your Agriculture" video, produced by Ag in the Classroom - Manitoba.	This video will encourage students to envision themselves pursuing careers in agriculture, regardless of their interests and/or strengths.
30 min	Students are given access to a copy of 'What's Your Something' (https://aitc-canada.ca/en-ca/for-educators/curriculum-linked-resources). Read through all of the 'Something's' together as a class, asking if any students want clarification. Ask students to choose one 'Something' that they enjoy. Have students use a laptop/iPad to research one of the careers listed under their 'Something', and complete the worksheet.	Students can link their passions/skills/strengths to jobs that exist in Agriculture, taking into account the education level required.
10 min	Students pair up and share their findings with a partner.	Students talk through their findings, allowing the information they collected to solidify and lead to further pondering regarding this future career path.
